OBJECTIVES AND INVESTMENT POLICY

This Fund is classified as follows: International equities

The Fund's investment objective is to outperform its benchmark, the STOXX Europe 600, net dividends reinvested, through investment funds, over a minimum investment horizon of eight years.

The Fund is managed on an active, discretionary basis. There are two stages to the investment process: a global macroeconomic analysis and fund selection according to qualitative and quantitative criteria.

The investment universe comprises funds investing at least 75% of their assets in EU member states, Iceland and Norway. The underlying funds' remaining assets may be invested in OECD countries and emerging markets. These funds shall be eligible for the PEA.

No geographic or sector allocation will be made at this stage.

The Fund invests at least 90% of its net assets in equity markets (by investing exclusively in PEA-eligible UCIs) through stocks of European Union companies of all capitalisation in order to be eligible for the PEA. Up to 100% of the Fund's net assets may be exposed to currency risk on EU currencies. Exposure to currency risk in currencies other than those from the European Union may not exceed 25% of the assets (including from emerging countries). Up to 30% of the Fund's net assets may also be exposed to commodities through funds that invest in companies belonging to this sector.

These investment funds will be French or foreign UCITS under Directive 2009/65/EC that may not invest more than 10% of their assets in units or shares of other UCITS, AIFs or investment funds or, within the limit of 30% of the Fund's assets, investment funds, French AIFs or AIFs from other EU member states, or investment funds established under foreign law. The units or shares of these AIFs and investment funds must meet the four criteria of article R.214-13 of the French Monetary and Financial Code. The investment funds will be compatible with the Fund's investment strategy and will be PEA-eligible.

Within the limit of 25%, the Fund may hold investment funds managed by ODDO BHF Asset Management SAS or ODDO BHF Asset Management GmbH.

The Fund may use forward financial instruments for the purposes of gaining exposure to or hedging against currency risk.

Subscription and redemption requests are centralised by the depositary every Paris stock exchange trading day until 17:45 (Paris time, CET/CEST) and executed on the basis of the net asset value of the following trading day.

The units accumulate their income.

Recommended investment horizon: 8 years

This Fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within this period.

RISK AND REWARD PROFILE

Why is the Fund placed in category 5?

The Fund presents a high level of risk as at least 90% of its assets are invested in EU equity markets and a significant portion may be allocated to small and mid caps.

Material risks to the Fund that are not taken into account in the indicator:

Liquidity risk: the Fund invests in markets which may be affected by declines in liquidity. Low volumes of market transactions may have an impact on prices at which the manager opens or closes positions.

Counterparty risk: the risk of a counterparty's collapse, causing it to default on payment. The Fund may be exposed to this risk resulting from the use of forward financial instruments or temporary purchases and sales of securities contracts negotiated over the counter with a credit institution if the latter is unable to honour its commitments.

If one of these risks were to materialise, the Fund's net asset value may fall.

CHARGES

Charges and fees paid are used to pay the costs of marketing and distributing units; these charges reduce the potential growth of the investment.

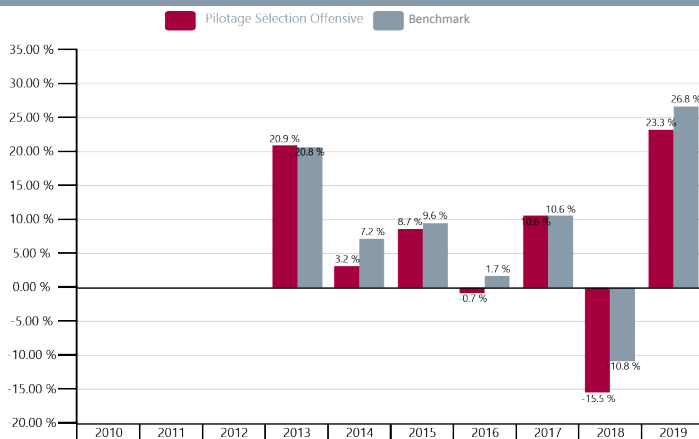
Ongoing charges are based on the expenses for the last financial year ended September 2019.
